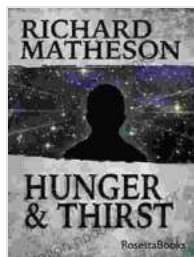


Hunger Thirst: A Novel That Will Haunt You Long After You Finish Reading

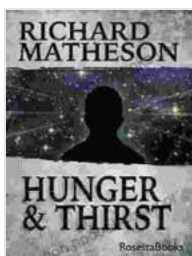

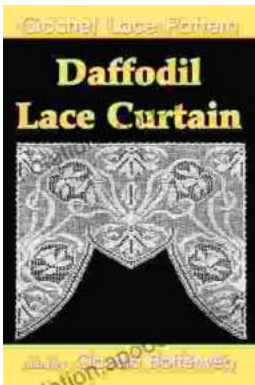
