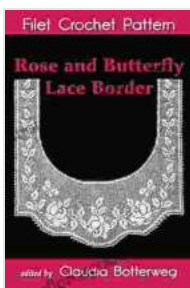

9. Row 11: Chain 3, turn. Single crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 sc)
10. Row 12: Chain 3, turn. Double crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 dc)
11. Row 13: Chain 3, turn. Single crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 sc)
12. Rows 14-17: Repeat Rows 10-13.
13. Row 18: Chain 3, turn. Double crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 dc)
14. Row 19: Chain 3, turn. Single crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 sc)
15. Row 20: Chain 3, turn. Double crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 dc)
16. Row 21: Chain 3, turn. Single crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 sc)
17. Rows 22-25: Repeat Rows 18-21.

18. Row 26: Chain 3, turn. Double crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 dc)
19. Row 27: Chain 3, turn. Single crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 sc)
20. Row 28: Chain 3, turn. Double crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 dc)
21. Row 29: Chain 3, turn. Single crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 sc)
22. Rows 30-33: Repeat Rows 26-29.
23. Row 34: Chain 3, turn. Double crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 dc)
24. Row 35: Chain 3, turn. Single crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 sc)
25. Row 36: Chain 3, turn. Double crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 dc)
26. Row 37: Chain 3, turn. Single crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 sc)
27. Rows 38-41: Repeat Rows 34-37.
28. Row 42: Chain 3, turn. Double crochet in the first stitch, and in each stitch across. (100 dc)

Finishing

Once you have finished crocheting the Rose and Butterfly Lace BFree Download Filet Crochet Pattern, you can finish it off by adding a bFree

Download. You can use any type of bFree Download that you like, but a simple single crochet bFree Download will work well.

To add a single crochet bFree Download, simply single crochet around the edge of the pattern, working into the spaces between the stitches.

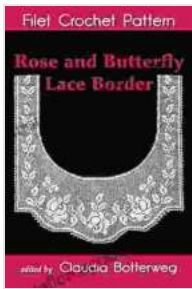

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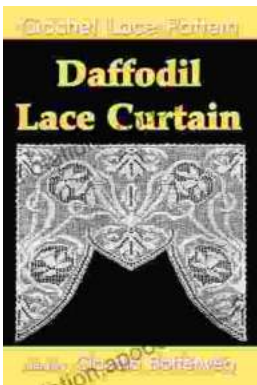
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
